TWENTY FIFTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

'You cannot serve both God and money'.

The old proverb tells us that the one who serves two masters has to lie to one. Our life is shaped by the end we desire. If the end we desire is to be with God we must make our preparations now. Our future is purchased by our present. In today already walks tomorrow. The Gospel today reminds us that serving God can never be a part time or spare time job. Our commitment to serve Him will manifest itself above all in our treatment of the poor. The 'Poor' are mentioned in one way or another in every ten lines of Scripture.
