20th SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

'The bread that I shall give is my flesh for the life of the world'.

When we eat our daily bread, that bread is digested and becomes part of us. When we approach the altar to partake of the Eucharist something different happens. We become what we eat. We become part of Him who is the Bread of Life. Consequently, we must live what we celebrate. We must 'earth' the Eucharist. Having 'communicated' we must make it show. His life flowing through us should manifest itself in how we think, speak and act. It should be obvious to all that He lives in us and we live in Him. The Eucharist is our highway to heaven. It's a highway that does not necessarily pass through worship or confession of faith, but through compassion for the least and the last. It is a road paved with concern and care for others. 'The Eucharist urges us to care especially for the poorest, most despised and most marginalized members of the Body of Christ' (Pope Francis). The Catechism of the Catholic Church further emphasizes the point: 'The Eucharist commits us to the poor'. The one Eucharistic bread makes us one body. The 'Bread of Life' discourse provides us with food for thought.
